#### WHAT DID WE DO?

- Held focus groups to find out what factors are associated with fearful, anxious behaviors in children.
- Explored topics like:

strengths, such as things that protected children from anxiety **risks**, such as things that increased anxiety in children

#### WHO PARTICIPATED?

- Focus groups represented multiple community members:
  - mothers, grandmothers, single-mothers, married mothers, fathers, homemaker,
  - social workers, daycare providers, home-makers, youth program directors

#### **CREATING A NEW INTERVENTION**

- Using the information from the focus groups, we are creating a new intervention to reduce fearful behavior and anxiety in young children.
- The intervention will include groups of parents and groups of children.
- We will teach parents and children what fear does to the body and thoughts, and we will help them learn to identify good fears and bad fears.
- Each session will teach parents and children skills that will help reduce anxiety. They will learn how to:

relax fight fears by facing fears parent fearful children
