PURPOSE & METHOD

The FAN-C Project explored parents' and adolescents thoughts about their neighborhoods, academics, everyday activities, and family interactions. Families filled out surveys and had group conversations.

PARTICIPANT CHARACTERISTICS



On average, adolescents were 13 years old

PARENT INVOLVEMENT WITH TEENS

Parents

· enjoyed spending time with their teens and watching them grow. · knew where their children were and what they were doing. were often involved in their academics at home and sometimes at school

· Steelton: most adolescents did not worry about getting stabbed, shot, or beaten up, · Harrisburg: most adolescents thought about getting shot, stabbed, or killed at least once a month

DEVIANT BEHAVIOR · Some teens skipped school, damaged property, or stole
